Dear Church Family and Supporters,

I am writing this letter from Tucson, Arizona, where the opportunity came to me to present my burden and vision for Haiti in some churches.

That trip was revolutionary to me. I can only say thank you to the Almighty and to those who are praying for me and Haiti.
